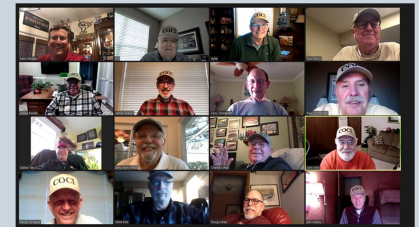
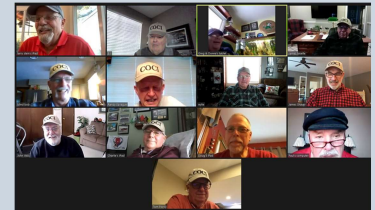
The C8 Explosion Continues
