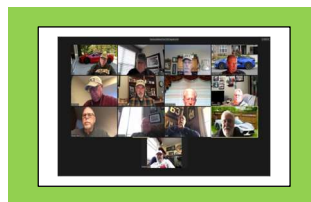
VFW Breakfasts & Real Golf
